



## BUILDING HYGIENE KITS AND WORKING WITH STREET LEVEL

## Here's what the team accomplished:

- Leveraged relationships with a local grocery store and manufacturer to obtain sample size packages of shampoo, soap, deodorant, band aids, toothbrushes, toothpaste, hand lotion, chapstick, granola bars, crackers and more!
- Filled 200 bags then, working with our Street Level Team, we handed them out to those waiting to get into one of our shelters.

The outreach provided through this program seeks to triage homeless people with on-the-spot response to needs like food, first aid supplies, hygiene items, referral services, spiritual counsel, prayer, and a listening ear.

## **Outcomes of the Street Level Team:**

- John had been homeless for two months and was not familiar with available resources in Seattle. Street Level Team was able to connect John to a Salvation Army Housing Navigator that found him an apartment based on his income.
- The Street Level Ministry Team helped a father and son, who were both chefs, find bus passes, work clothes, sleeping bags, and backpacks, so they could interview for jobs.
